Statement of Significance Built in 1918, McClain Motors, the Desoto and Plymouth dealer is listed there in the 1936 city directory. Ross Stover was later owner in a furniture store. Also Bushell's Furniture.

Description of Physical Appearance Rectangular concrete barrel roof building has a false front with crenellated parapet. Six newer plate glass display windows are across the front (north) facade. A central double door entry with metal framed plate glass commercial doors. East, west and south side bays have been filled in with concrete block.
