Statement of Significance An ornate Queen Anne style house, the building exhibits unusual latticework on its facade. The house was built ca. 1891 by David and Sarah Mitchell. Mitchell is listed in the city directory as a barber.

Description of Physical Appearance The Mitchell House is a rectangular, two-and-one-half-story wood frame structure of simplified Queen Anne style. Its gable roof is covered with composition shingles and has close eaves with a simple molded cornice; front and rear two-story extensions have hipped, pedimented gable roofs. Walls are clad with drop siding and cornerboards, with fishscale shingles in the gable and in a band between stories set off by horizontal banding. The foundation is skirted with vertical boards. A one-story, hip-roofed porch wraps around the front (east) and south facades, sheltering the main entry door; the porch is fronted by latticework panels with round openings and a round archway framing the door. A recessed second-story balcony above the porch has similar latticework with a round opening. Adjacent to the porch is a wide plate glass window with a leaded glass transom; other fenestration includes double-hung sash with one-over-one lights, and arched double-hung windows in the gables. Spanning the rear facade is a one-story, shed-roofed enclosed porch. At the northwest corner is a gable-roofed shed.
