**Statement of Significance**

The building was built in 1923 to serve the auto repair trade. The 1936 city directory listed the property as the Willard Spencer Auto Repairs Co. And in 1941 Spoon Auto parts moved into the building. It was remodeled in 1947 by Joseph Wohleb and appears to have undergone renovation since that time. Documentation is informational only.

**Description of Physical Appearance**

Flat roofed one story building faced with green aggregate facing material. Seven bays on the north side have newer three-section metal windows, one of the bays has been filled in and one has a vehicle access bay. Corner recessed entry on the northwest corner has a false front and slated entry door section. It is supported by a square post, also covered in green aggregate. Entry is a metal frame commercial glass door and is flanked by glass block sidelights and newer plate glass windows. Two bays on the west side have newer plate glass windows and one glass block window.
