Statement of Significance Built in 1891 by Pamela Hale, Thurston County First Woman Superintendent of Schools and the wife of Calvin Hale. She was a prominent businesswoman. J.E. Kelley Furniture store was located here. Registered as a site only.

Description of Physical Appearance Two story rectangular, concrete building. Newer display windows on the first floor with a recessed entry. Entry door has wood frame transom and sidelights. There is an entry on the east end with a stairway up to second floor apartments. The second floor has seven small double hung sash windows and 15 similar windows on the west side second floor. The first floor has some arched windows on the west side and the northwest corner has a plate glass storefront and recessed wood frame entry.
