Jay and Myrtle Bolster bought the house in 1921. Bolster had the Hupmobile agency in the 1925 City Directory. A. B. Hawks owned the property from 1913 to 1921 .

Description of Physical Appearance

Dutch Colonial style house with front entry on the west end gable. Wide shed roof dormers are on the north and south sides of the house. There is a large brick chimney on the south side of the house. The front entry is set under a shed roof porch with plain pillars. Windows are one-over-one double hung sash. There is a one story hipped roof addition on the east side and a side entry with a shed roof on the south side. There is a square vent in the front gable.
