Significance**

St. John's Episcopal Church was built in two phases. The main administrative wing was constructed in 1949 in the late Gothic style. It was designed by Harld C. Whitehouse from Spokane. In 1957 a main sanctuary space was added to the existing structure.

Appearance**

St. John's Episcopal Church encompasses one entire block on Capitol Way and 20th Street. The Sanctuary, constructed in 1957 sits perpendicular to Capitol Way. The building is a two story mass of concrete and yellow brick. The nave space is punctured by
