Statement of Significance This was built by Dan Munro a local builder according to available information.

Description of Physical Appearance This is a two story, vernacular style building built of brick with a stucco finish at the corner of State and Columbia on the west side of downtown. The rectangular, flat roofed building which has three storefront bays facing on Columbia. The south storefront is recessed with a marble-faced vestibule while the others are flush with the sidewalk. They all have metal replacement plate glass storefront windows with flush metal frame entries with some marble detailing. The second floor has four, paired one-over-one double hung sash replacement windows.
