Statement of Significance This was the location historically of the Yeager Saloon. It was later the site of the Liberty Café owned by the Wisniewski Family who built the building.

Description of Physical Appearance This is a one story, rectangular concrete building with a flat roof and parapet front section facing on E. 4th Avenue. The front (south) has two entries into the storefront. The east side has metal framed plate glass window with a recessed area faced in brick below it. The west entry has glass display windows extending to the sidewalk. The parapet and west walls of the building have a rectangular incised design in the concrete.
