

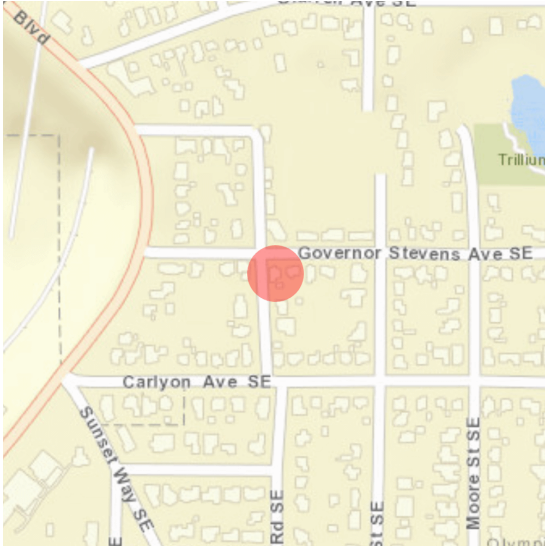

Significance narrative: The house is difficult to assess because of foliage growing so close to walls and windows. It appears that it retains integrity in design, but that additions to the entry and to the south elevation may have compromised its integrity.

Physical description: 603 Governor Stevens is a Minimal Traditional, cross-gabled, one-and-a-half story house facing north on a northwest corner lot. The house is defined by a series of gables facing north and west, each with narrow eaves. The house is essentially square in plan with a front facing gable, a second projecting front facing gable on the northwest corner and a projecting side gable on the northwest corner. The house is approached from the west by a set of stairs leading to an enclosed stoop. The stoop is front-gabled with a shallow hood supported by decorative brackets above the door on the enclosed porch's west elevation. The hood is not original. The house is clad in wood boards. A pair of original wood windows facing north on the primary facade has been replaced with a single fixed wood window. Other windows are invisible behind mature plantings. A new window has been added to the half story on the primary facade. The house has a large chimney centered on the side-gable at the northwest corner. An addition has been added to the south elevation. It is visible from the street.
