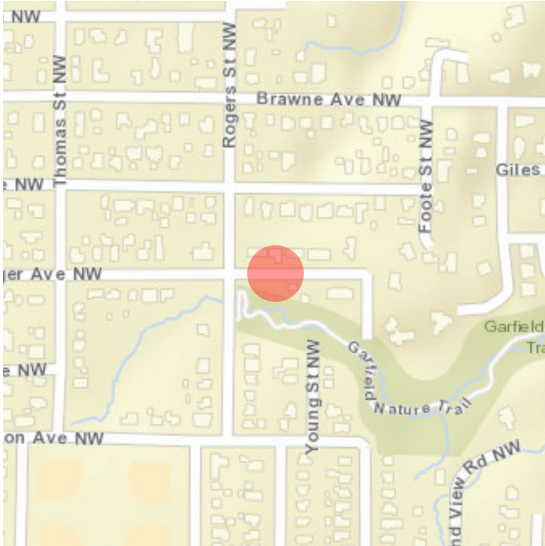

## Surveyor Opinion

**Significance narrative:** The Jacob Duplex is a very unique and unusual dwelling within the confines of Olympia. The building represents a non-traditional approach to duplex design for the 1950s.

**Physical description:** Located in a densely wooded site, the Jacobs Duplex is a rectangular wood frame box which rests upon a concrete block one story utility space. The raised living area created a carport for each duplex. The dwelling has a flat roof, T-1-11 siding and aluminum sliding windows. Exterior stairs on the east and west ends of the south façade allows access to the second story living space.
