

Wednesday Evening April 3rd 1872

Be it Remembered that at a Municipal Election held in the Town of Olympia on Monday the First day of April 1872 it being the first Monday of said Month and the day appointed by law for holding such Election, The following named persons were duly elected for the ensuing year,

For Mayor, W. W. Miller

For Trustees of First Ward Benjamin Bellman
A. J. Burr,

For Second Ward Marshall Blinn
T. J. McElroy

For Third Ward J. S. Deffenis
S. S. Henry,

A. Phillips

Whereupon the above named Mayor, and Trustees elected met at the Town Hall on Wednesday evening April 3rd at 7 o'clock P. M. - On the call of the roll, all being present were duly qualified,

Mr. President in the Chair.

Mr. McElroy moved that when this Board adjourn, it adjourn until Friday evening next, at 7 o'clock P. M. and that the appointment of Town Officers, be postponed until such meeting, - which motion was unanimously carried

The Official Bonds of the Treasurer and Town Marshal were fixed at \$12,000 Twelve thousand dollars each to be approved by the Board

Mr. President having suggested that some action be taken to get authority from Congress to borrow money to take up the outstanding notes of this Town and fund the same at a lower rate of interest,

Mr. McElroy moved that the Chair appoint a Special Committee of three to act in connection with the Mayor to memorialize Congress for authority to borrow a sum of money ^{not exceeding \$25,000.} at a rate of interest not exceeding 10 per cent per annum. Motion carried, and Messrs. McElroy, Blinn, & Pettman appointed as such Committee.

On Motion of Mr. McElroy the Committee in conjunction with the Mayor, were authorized to borrow a sum not exceeding \$25,000. at a rate of interest not exceeding 10 per cent per annum.

A Bill was presented from D. J. Conner for repairing draw Ponds on Marshall Bridge, which on Motion was referred to Special Committee of three consisting of Messrs. McElroy, Henry, & Dobbin.

Mr. Blinn moved that the President appoint a Special Committee of three to supervise the Streets until the appointment of the Standing Committee.

Motion carried, and Messrs. Blinn, Burr and Henry appointed as such Committee.
